**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY & DATE**

The Columbia Yacht Club and Boaters World is the organizing authority. The Columbia Yacht shall be the host club and will provide race management. The first warning signal shall be at 11:00PM Saturday June 8th and at 10:00AM Sunday June 9th .

**2. RULES**

2.1 The race shall be governed by the 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Racing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (USSA) thereto, the rules and regulations of the Farr 40, Mumm 30, J-105, SYD38, BEN40.7, and GL70 classes. The ORC Special Regulations for Category 4, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2.2 There will be no alterations of class rules.

**3. ADVERTISING**

The regatta is classified as a Category B event in accordance with RRS Appendix G par. 4.

**4.ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

4.1 This regatta is open to the rules of the the Farr 40, Mumm 30, J-105, SYD38, BEN40.7, GL70 and any group of 3 or more boats racing level .

4.2 Eligible yachts may be entered by completing and signing the entry form included with the Notice of Race and paying the \$125.00 entry fee plus \$5.00 if not member of US SAILING.

4.3. Submission of evidence of that the yacht carries \$300,000 of Liability Insurance for the period of the race.

4.4 Yachts sailing must meet their respective class rules.

4.5 The entry form with appropriate fee shall be submitted no later than May 31, 2002 to-

## 5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5.1 Sign-in: Friday June 7,2002 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at Columbia Y.C.

5.2 Races: The races will be windward/leeward courses. It is the intention to have six(6) races in any configuration. The first warning is 11:00AM on Saturday and 10:00AM on Sunday. Each section will have their own start with 5 minute intervals.

5.3 A skippers meeting will held on Friday June 7,2002 at 7:30 p.m. at Columbia Yacht Club.

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be made available at sign-in.

## 7. REGATTA SITE and RACING AREA

7.1 The regatta site will be the Columbia Yacht Club Chicago, IL.

7.2 The racing area will be offshore in the vicinity of Monroe Harbor. Final location will be in the sailing instructions.

## 8. SCORING

8.1 Individual races will be scored by the low point scoring system (RRS2.2)

8.2 The regattas score will be based on the low point scoring system( RRS A2.2), except that each yachts series score will be the total for all the races started. **No throw outs.**

## 9. PENALTIES

The 360degree turns penalty of the RRS par. 44 will apply.

## 10. PRIZES

Awards will be presented by Boater World and Columbia Yacht Club to One Design yachts and their crews finishing first, second and third in each section in the regatta on Sunday June 9th at Columbia Y.C. at approximately 5:00 PM.

## 11. Entertainment

Columbia Yacht Club will have a party on Friday night. Boaters World and Columbia Yacht Club will provide refreshments after the races on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
